WITHDRAWAL
FROM SUMMER
SCHOOL

The following procedures have been developed in order to establish uniform withdrawal dates from summer school sessions:

1. In a summer term (either six- or eleven week term) a student may withdraw from a class and receive a grade of "W" during the period from the fourth class day up to the last eleven class days of that term (excluding scheduled final examination days).
2. After the last day to withdraw from class has passed, a student is expected to take the final examination and receive the grade earned in the course.
3. A student who does not officially withdraw from a class will be given a grade of "zero" in all work that is missed.
