

SPECIAL
PERFORMANCE
SCHOLARSHIP
PROGRAM

In an effort to provide encouragement and recognition to students not eligible for need scholarships, the college hereby establishes a special performance scholarship program. Recipients shall be selected on merit. Financial need of applicants and others considered for special performance scholarships will not be a major factor.

The following rules and regulations shall be established in an effort to ensure fair and impartial implementation of the program:

1. The recipient shall enroll and remain enrolled as a full-time student at Brazosport College (twelve or more hours) and maintain an overall 2.0 grade point average (grade of C). Performance and other criteria will be established for scholarships in specific areas. Example: The music department may require participation in certain music-related activities, take at least one music course, or have completed a minimum number of credit hours in music, etc.
2. The organization or group sponsor shall recommend prospective recipients to the director of financial aid for awarding the scholarship to the student. The sponsor shall attest to the fact that the proposed recipient meets criteria established for the particular scholarship. The recommended recipient shall attest that he or she understands the terms of the scholarship.
3. The same approval procedure shall be followed in renewing a scholarship as was followed in awarding it initially. Scholarships must be renewed on a semester to semester basis.
4. Scholarship funds are generally budgeted for the following areas:

The special performance scholarship program will be under direct supervision of the director of financial aid.

INTRAMURAL AWARDS

Awards for the intramural program shall be of three types and shall be awarded as described below:

CERTIFICATES

1. First place certificates shall be awarded each individual who scores first place in an individual event or is a member of a team who scores first place in a team event.
2. Second place certificates will be awarded each individual who scores second place in an individual event or who is a member of a team that scores second place in a team event.
3. Each individual shall receive no more than one first place certificate and one second place certificate in any one year. In the event that the individual scores first place in more than one event, the events shall be listed on the first place certificate. In the event that the individual scores second place in more than one event, all second places shall be listed on the second place certificate.
4. Certificates shall be awarded at the spring awards activity.

- T-SHIRT AWARD
5. A T-shirt award shall be awarded each individual who accumulates four or more points in any one school year. All the points must be in unrelated sports.
 6. Each individual may earn only one T-shirt award per year.
 7. T-shirt awards shall be awarded as soon as practicable after the point total is achieved and upon application by the student. Application forms are available in the intramural office.

- TROPHY AWARD
8. A first place trophy will be awarded the male student who accumulates the largest number of points in each school year, and a first place trophy will be awarded to the female student who accumulates the largest number of points in each school year. In case of a tie, the students who tie will receive first place trophies and no second place trophy will be awarded.
 9. A second place trophy will be awarded the male student who accumulates the second largest number of points in each school year, and a second place trophy will be awarded to the female student who accumulates the second largest number of points in each school year. In case of a tie, duplicate second place trophies will be awarded.
 10. Trophies will only be awarded to students who earn eight or more points.
 11. The trophies will be awarded at the spring awards activity.

Point system for T-shirt and trophy awards shall be as follows:

1. The point system listed below shall be used to calculate points needed for the awards:
 - a. Three points for each first place in an individual event or as a member of a first place team.
 - b. Two points for each second place in an individual event or as a member of a second place team.
 - c. One point for each third place in an individual event or as a member of a third place team.

2. In the event that a student places first, second, or third in the same activity during one school year, only the highest of the point values may be used to compute points for awards.
3. In order to be eligible for a T-shirt award or a trophy award, the student must be currently enrolled for at least three hours in the semester or semesters at the time the points are earned.
