ADMISSIONS POLICY

PRODUCTIONS
ADMISSION PRICES

Prices for admission to theatrical productions will be set by the drama department and shall be subject to changes as needed.

1. Adults will pay general admissions for Thursday, Friday and Saturday evening performances.
2. Children under 12 - one-half of adult price.

SEASON TICKETS

A season ticket shall include eight tickets [2 per show] for the regular season and will be used as the season ticket holder desires.

STUDENT TICKETS

All college students may be admitted free to any performance upon presentation of their student I.D.

DEPOSIT OF
MONEY FROM
SALE OF TICKETS

All money collected from the sale of tickets to drama productions of college student productions shall be deposited in a special account established for drama revenues.

COMPLIMENTARY
TICKETS

The director of drama activities shall be authorized to provide the following persons with complimentary tickets to productions:

1. Area high school drama and fine arts teachers.
2. Directors of area community theatres.
3. Drama department heads at area junior and senior colleges.
4. Area high school drama students as recommended by high school drama coaches.
5. Each member of each show's cast and crew may receive two tickets for any performances.
6. Selected individuals who provide material assistance in the production.
7. Working members of the press.

DISCOUNT
TICKETS

Tickets for less than general admission prices are awarded as follows:

1. College employees are offered 50% discount on season tickets.
2. Groups of fifteen or more by advance reservation are offered a 50% discount for a single performance if space is available.

Contributions shall be governed by the following:

An "angel" is a contributor of \$20, \$50 (Archangel) and \$100 (Heavenly Benefactor) or more above the normal season ticket price who wishes to make a contribution to the college's drama program. An "angel" may designate whether the contribution should be used for drama scholarships or the drama production fund. Names of contributors will be published in program unless they specifically request otherwise.

PERFORMANCES
IN EXCESS OF
REGULAR SEASON

Summer productions are free admissions.

Rehearsal admission shall be governed by the following:

1. Selected groups, may be invited to the final dress rehearsals without charge.
2. Rehearsals of all college plays are subject to the same regulations as any other class. Rehearsals may be open to individuals who, in the opinion of the director, will not detract from the rehearsal procedures.
