APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

Financial aid helps students and their families pay for college. This financial assistance covers educational expenses, including tuition, fees, books, and supplies. There are several types of financial aid that may be combined into your financial aid award. Students are encouraged to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application to Brazosport College. Students will need this application to apply for federal and state grants, scholarships, and on-campus employment (work study).

BACTERIAL MENINGITIS VACCINE

A proof of the bacterial meningitis vaccination or a valid exemption is required for anyone under the age of 22 attending classes on Brazosport College campus. Students who will be 22 years of age or older on the first day of the semester are not required to submit bacterial meningitis vaccine information.

SUBMIT PLACEMENT TEST SCORES

Upon entering Brazosport College all degree-seeking students are required to take the TSI Assessment test, or meet an exemption. The TSI Assessment will determine your entry-level for the subjects of reading, writing, and math.
